The technician will report to the logistics supervisor, the schedule is a 14-day on/ 14 day off 10 hours/day rotation.

Responsibilities:

- Work according to the company's environmental policy

 - Spot and flag diamond drill pads and access points
 - Diamond drill inspections including pre, during and post environmental inspections
 - Update field tracking and inspection sheets

 - Monitor pad cutters or slasher onsite
 - Perform environmental inspections on the mine site
- Assist in water treatment:
 - Operate according to the operating manual and procedures
 - Start and stop treatment according to the volume of water to be treated
 - Sample as per procedure
 - Adjust treatment parameters according to conditions to ensure that the effluent complies with regulations
