Responsibilities

- Work with the Project Manager, Wallbridge employees and contractors to ensure that work at the Fénélon project is carried out safely and in accordance with applicable laws and regulations;
- Ensure that all team members and contractors strictly comply with the applicable health and safety rules and regulations, as well as Wallbridge's health and safety rules;
- Mentor Wallbridge employees on the site to promote health and safety;
- Take charge of communications, inspection visits and case management with CNESST;
- Coordinate incident and accident investigation processes and ensure corrective action is in place;
- Compile data to calculate health and safety statistics at Project Fénélon in Sofvie;
- Coordinate, conduct and document health and safety inspections at Project Fénélon;
- Coordinate annual safety drills;
- Prepare for monthly health and safety meetings and assist in the administration of the JHSC;
- Prepare monthly themes and daily safety health messages;
- Develop the necessary work procedures in collaboration with Wallbridge employees and contractors;
- Establish the personal protective equipment requirements, validate suppliers and ensure proper use of equipment;
- Ensure site orientations are being completed prior to site access (via Norcat);
- In collaboration with HR, ensure employee training records in Quebec are entered in Sofvie;
- Organize training and annual refreshers as required for the Wallbridge Québec employees.
